

Minimum requirements for waste management service providers

Port of Naantali Ltd puts the waste management services out to tender at regular intervals. The minimum requirements related to waste management services are published in connection to the call for tenders. Some vessels coming to the Port of Naantali have been granted an exemption from the mandatory delivery of waste based on a separate decision by the authorities.

Currently Port of Naantali Ltd has agreements concerning the following waste management: collection and transport of dangerous waste, oil waste, solid waste and sewage from vessels.

Port of Naantali Ltd has a valid waste management plan, approved by the Centre for Economic Development, Transport and the Environment of Southwest Finland. Maritime Environmental Protection Act (1672/2009, Section 9, 3§) requires the port to draw up a waste management plan on the management of waste from vessels coming to the port. The waste management plan and its appendices describe the execution and minimum requirements of waste management.
