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WASTE MANAGEMENT FEES

GENERAL PRINCIPLES

Merchant shipping vessels mooring at the quay in the port of Naantali are charged waste management fees as follows:

Vessels that intend to use the port's waste disposal services for oily residues or for lavatory waste are required to notify the port no later than 24 hours prior to arrival or immediately after leaving the previous port if the voyage takes less than 24 hours.

If the final port of arrival is known less than 24 hours before arriving at this port, notification must be submitted immediately after the port determination is made.

Solid waste

Household and similar regular operations on waste from the vessels must be sorted according to the Waste Management Instructions of the Port of Naantali. Separate containers for each type of waste are available at the waste facilities.

The waste management fee for a cargo vessel is €/ net tonnage as follows:

Sorted waste 0.10 €
Minimum fee 55.00 €

If vessels deliver unsorted waste contrary to the Regulations, the fee charged in €/net tonnage is as follows:

Unsorted waste 0.26 €
Minimum fee 165.00 €

Oily waste fee, includes for disposing of grey water and sewage

A waste management fee of 0.18 €/net tonnage is charged for oily waste from the engine room. The oily waste fee does not include the reception of cargo residue. The charge includes for disposing of grey water and sewage directly into the port's sewage disposal system.

In regular ferry traffic according to a contract.

For amounts of waste that are exceptionally large in terms of normal use or traffic and amounts of waste that exceed the storage capacity for operating waste and waste from the flue gas cleaning system, the vessels are charged according to the actual costs.

The pumping power requirement for oily waste is 3 m³/h after which the fee is charged according to the actual costs.

If vessels exempt from the waste management fees deliver waste using the port services, they are charged on the basis of the actual costs.

The minimum waste management fee charged is 110.00 €.

The vessel waste fee is not charged on vessels granted special permission for the treatment of oily residues by the Finnish Transport Safety Agency Trafi pursuant to the Waste Act on Vessels.



WASTE MANAGEMENT FEES

Hazardous waste

Hazardous waste is included in the vessel waste fee for solid waste as far as the waste has been generated in the regular operations of the vessel. The fee for hazardous waste generated in other than regular operations of the vessel shall be charged in accordance with the actual costs.

Discounts on vessel waste fees

The Port of Naantali grants 3 % discount on the solid waste fee to vessels that

• operate in short sea shipping (less than 48 hours have passed since the vessel's previous port call when it arrives in the port)

OR

• have an approved ESI certificate with a score of over 70 points (http://www.environmentalshipindex.org/)

The certificates required for the discount or similar grounds for discount shall be presented **no later than 72 hours before the arrival** of the vessel in the port. If the certificates required for the discount or similar grounds for discount are valid for a fixed period, the recipient of the discount shall see to it that the grounds for discount are up to date and provide the information to the Port. The discount shall not be granted afterwards.

The Port of Naantali reserves the right to amend the grounds for granting discount on vessel waste fees, the amount of discount, and other terms and conditions concerning discount on vessel waste fees.

Waste from the freight must be cleaned within seven (7) days after the vessel has left the port, after which the fee is charged on the basis of the actual costs, with an additional 10% fee for the general overhead cost of the port.



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
